NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PORTAGE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, March 26, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. in Conference Room 5 of the County Annex, 1462 Strongs Avenue, Stevens Point, the Portage County Planning and Zoning Committee will hold a public hearing to receive comments on the updated Portage County Comprehensive Plan and the proposed ordinance to adopt the plan.

The Portage County Comprehensive Plan was updated pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes §66.1001 and the update included reviewing information such as natural, agricultural, and cultural resources, housing, utilities and community facilities, transportation, economic development, land uses, and mapping, and intergovernmental cooperation.
